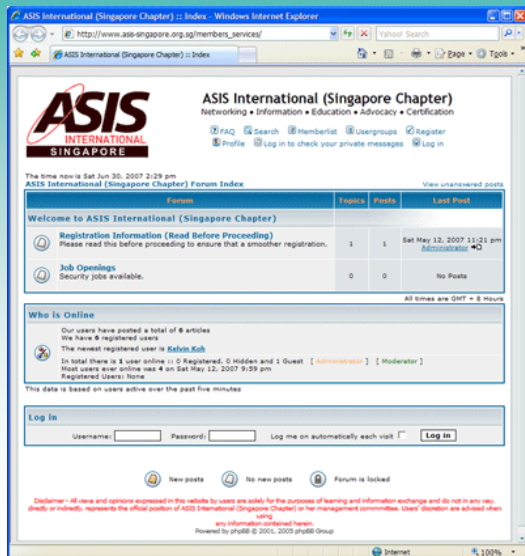
The Management Committee trust that our members will realise that their local Chapter membership will add value to their professional development and network.
