Updates to Physical Security Systems Guidelines Webinar

Security Industry Institute organized a webinar on “Updates to Physical Security Systems Guidelines” on the 11th March 2022. Speakers from Center for Protective Security, Singapore Police Force; and ASIS (Singapore Chapter) were invited to speak. 86 participants attended the webinar.

Mr Kang Kheng Wee from the CPS shared changes to the newly revised Video Surveillance System (VSS) Standard for Buildings. While the VSS Standard is not mandatory for general buildings, it is a useful guide for practitioners employing video surveillance systems in Singapore. Under the revised Standard, additional coverage for perimeter, video analytics, cybersecurity and PDPA were added to better guide the VSS planning process. Minimum recommended resolution remains at 1080p and compliance to ONVIF is recommended to ensure optimum interoperability with other security products. The new standard is expected to be launched in end March 2022.

Our own Jeffrey Lam presented on “Employing integrated security systems for Critical Facilities”. Electronic security systems (ESS) have evolved over the years and are no longer confined to server-based systems but can now be deployed through edge devices as well as the cloud. Through the use of video and audio analytics as well as integrated ESS, basic deter and delay tactics may be automated. Security Officers at the Security Command Center now has some breathing space to verify the incident before initiating an appropriate response. By automating ESS, response time and decision making in managing threats are greater improved.

We thank SII for inviting us and we look forward to partnering with them again in future.

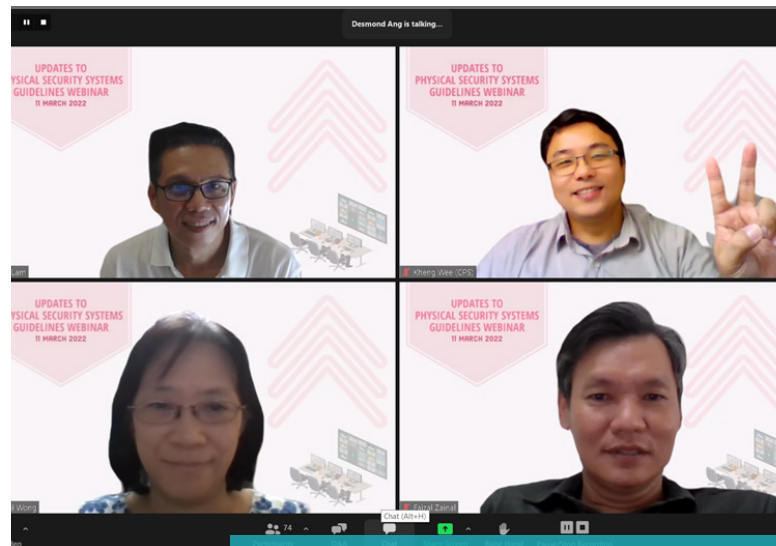

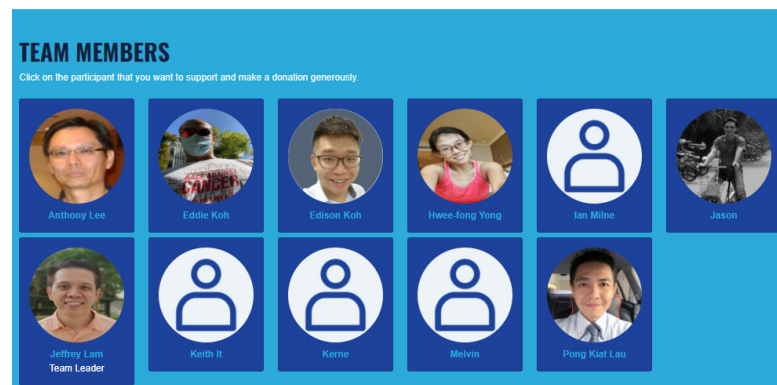
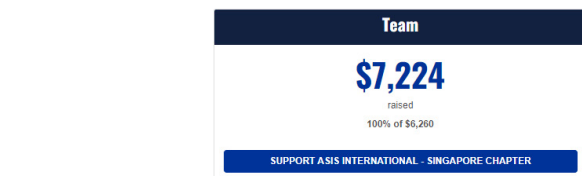
Corporate Social Responsibility Relay for Life 2022

Relay For Life (RFL) is a global movement with close to 4 million participants annually, making it one of the world's largest fundraisers. Singapore is the 25th member country to organise RFL and it aims to rally the local community to celebrate the lives of those who battled cancer, remember loved ones lost, and fight back against a disease that has taken many lives.

As part of our CSR efforts, the Chapter signed up for this and over 9 days in March 2022, 11 local chapter and MC members teamed up to run, cycle (and even swim) our way towards the goal. Together, our team hit 520% of our distance goal, and 115% of our fund raising goal.

The event achieved \$1.16m of their \$1.15m objective. All donations go direct to the Singapore Cancer Society and all local donations are eligible for IRAS tax deduction of 2.5 times the donated amount.

We would like to thank everyone for their generous donations.
